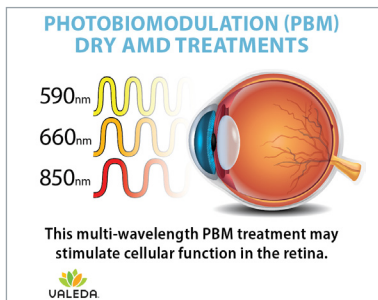

ASSESSMENT & TREATMENT COURSE
